The following information comes from the official user manual provided by the manufacturer – **GIB MEBLE**

- Before assembly, check the completeness of the parts, fittings, and accessories, and read the assembly instructions included in the package. The furniture should not be treated as a toy. The furniture must be used according to its intended purpose.
- For safety reasons, the furniture should be permanently attached to the wall (to prevent it from tipping over or falling). Mounting brackets (depending on the type of furniture) are included in the set and should be used during assembly. The appropriate dowels should be purchased by the installer, as the type of dowel depends on the type of wall. The wall itself should be made of solid and durable materials. The furniture should not be tilted or climbed on, as this may cause it to topple.
- Access to the furniture, its assembly parts, and packaging should be restricted for children or individuals with intellectual disabilities. This is due to the risk of injury or suffocation. Care should also be taken to avoid sharp edges on the furniture.
- To ensure proper functioning, the furniture must be stabilized and its level and vertical alignment adjusted. Make sure that the diagonals of the back panel (if the furniture design includes one) are equal, and that the angle between the side panel and the top panel is 90°.
- To ensure the proper functioning of the furniture, the door hinges must be adjusted. Incorrect adjustment or lack thereof may result in damage to the furniture.
- Heavy objects must not be placed on the furniture. You must follow the specified maximum load limits of the furniture.
- Furniture should be cleaned with a dry or slightly damp soft cloth, and the cleaned surfaces should then be wiped dry. Glossy surfaces should be cleaned only with a dry, soft cloth. Laminated surfaces can be wiped with a damp cloth and immediately dried with a soft, dry cloth. Corrosive chemical agents must not be used for maintenance. Scrubbing should be avoided.
- Packaging and filling materials should be disposed of in accordance with waste segregation rules by placing them in designated containers. If necessary, furniture should be disposed of by placing it in large waste containers or transporting it to a designated location. If the furniture is still usable, it can be sold, donated to those in need, or given to charitable organizations.
